1 ONLINE B.A./B.S IN CRIMINAL JUSTICE

The B.A. /B.S CJ curriculum is designed to prepare graduates for positions in the field of criminal justice in local, county, state and federal justice agencies, private security organizations, and related fields; and to prepare students for graduate work in criminal justice or related disciplines.

2 ONLINE M.S. IN CRIMINAL JUSTICE

The M.S.CJ offers students an in-depth exploration of the complex and changing world of criminal justice. The historical, political, economic and philosophical forces shaping crime and punishment in the U.S. are examined.

3 ONLINE MS IN CRIMINAL JUSTICE + MASTER OF PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION DUAL DEGREE
