



Legal Studies Minor

The Legal Studies minor is well suited for students seeking to understand the universal role of law in society. This minor is available for all undergraduate students. Students who pursue the Legal Studies minor will find this knowledge in nearly every aspect of their professional careers.

The Minor in Legal Studies is **18 credit hours**. Students must take **PLA 3014 Law & the Legal System** and complete **fifteen (15)** additional credit hours of PLA courses from the concentrations listed below. Students must select **one (1)** course from at least **three (3)** of the following areas of concentration. The remaining **six (6)** credit hours can be from any concentration. Students must earn a "C" or better in all coursework.
