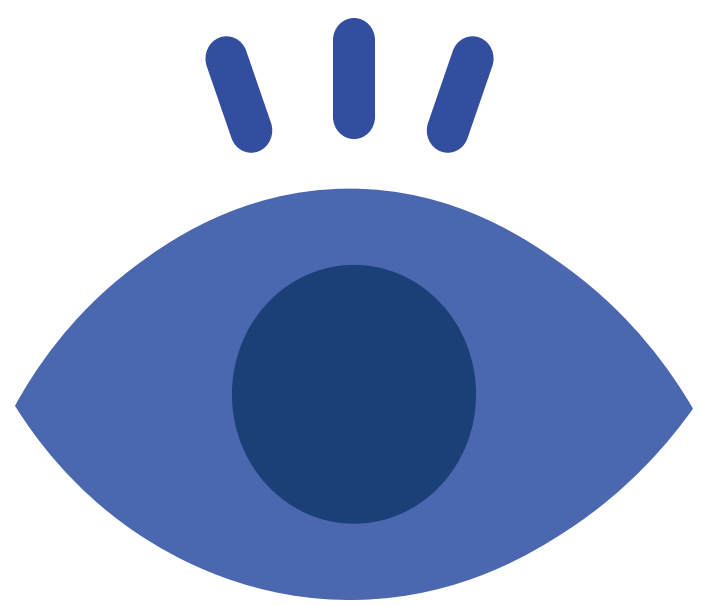

For teachers who wish to advance their career as a program director, coordinator, or other administrator type position.

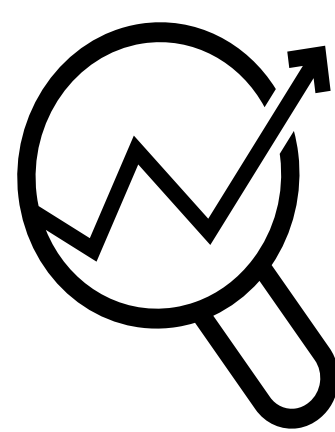
Program at a glance:
