College Internship Program

Program Description:

The intern will be exposed to the supervision of defendant's released on bond in Federal Court and the preparation of pretrial services reports. This program will provide a unique opportunity for the student to participate in a work environment which will provide exposure to the administration of the U.S. District Court, various federal and state law enforcement agencies, the U.S. Attorney's Office, Federal Public Defender's Office, private law firms and numerous community service agencies.

U.S. Pretrial Services for the Middle District of Florida has five locations (Jacksonville, Ocala, Orlando, Tampa, and Ft. Myers) and can accommodate two interns at the Orlando Division. Start/End dates and hours per week are based on your academic institution's requirements.

Who should apply?

Junior, Senior, or Master level Criminal Justice, Criminology, Sociology majors and other areas of study where the student is interested in the field of criminal justice and has completed courses in corrections. This internship must be completed prior to graduation.
