TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE

PRESENTATIONS FACILITATION

Topics include Community Schools 101, Typology and Approaches, and Community Partnership Schools.

STRATEGIC DISCUSSION FACILITATION

Topics include community school vision, mission and core principles, partner roles and responsibilities, certification preparation, and yearly goals and objectives.

IN-PERSON AND VIRTUAL CONSULTATION AND COACHING

The UCF Center provides multiple workshop series and ongoing coaching and consultation to individuals and small groups, whether in-person or by phone, email or video chat.
