* In 2022-23, Florida appropriated \$7,180,571, with a required 25% match of \$1,795,143. Additionally, the legislature reverted remaining FY2021-22 funds of \$648,860. A total of \$7,829,431 was provided by the legislature to support the Community School Grant Program. The match includes dollars and in-kind donations.
